Maths

Building 11-15

Using counters or building bricks, make the numbers 11-15, by making a set of 10, then adding 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5. Talk about how the pattern of 11-15 is similar to that of 1-5.

Building 16-20

Using counters or building bricks, make the numbers 16-20, by making a set of 10, then adding 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10. Talk about how the pattern of 16-20 is similar to that of 6-10.

Shape Collage

Using objects create pictures and talk about why and how you have used different shapes for different parts of the picture, using mathematical language. E.g. Make a picture of a car, I used circles for the wheels because circles are round or curved.

Sorting and matching representations of 11-20

Collect and make sets of different ways of showing the numbers 11-20. E.g. the numerals 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, towers of bricks, dominoes etc
