Use objects to create and tell your own subtraction stories.
E.g. First I had 8 sweets.
Then I ate 3 sweets
Now I have 5 sweets

#### Maths

'First, then, now' subtracting stories

Tell subtracting stories as we did yesterday, but this time try to say out loud the number sentence for what is happening.

E.g. 8 - 3 = 5

### Maths

'Pass it on' game

Apply your addition and subtraction skills to this game: Each player starts with 6 objects. Roll a1-3 dice or pick a card that has 1-3 on it. Pass that number on to the player on your left. Keep going until someone has passed all their objects on.

Ask your grown up to put up to 10 objects in front of you and then cover them up with a tea towel. Your grown up will then take some away from under the towel. When the towel is removed can you work out how many they subtracted?
