LOOK, SAY, COVER, WRITE, CHECK

LOOK: Have a good look at the word. What letter does it begin and end with? Does it have a prefix/suffix? Does it have any double letters? Are there any tricky bits?

SAY: Say your word out loud.

COVER: Cover up the word.

WRITE: Have a go at writing the

word.

CHECK: Did you get it right? If not, which bit did you get wrong? How could you try and remember that bit for next time? Re-write the word correctly a few times.
