English

This term we will be doing a non-fiction unit on Incredible Sports, a fiction unit all about Greek myths and to finish off we will be exploring some poetry!

Mathematics

We will be looking at becoming confident with multiplication and division using standard method. We will also be looking at finding the area of a rectilinear shape and we will begin to look at fractions!

Science

We will be identifying appliances that run on electricity and making our own circuits.

History
