Achieve 100

We are excited to introduce a new whole-class incentive program designed to encourage collaboration and focus on school-wide goals.

When a class works together effectively to demonstrate a key school focus (e.g., excellent presentation, collaborative working etc..), they will be awarded one point. Once the class collectively reaches 100 points, the entire class will receive a special collective award or celebration as a reward for their teamwork and achievement!

This initiative is aimed at fostering a strong sense of community and shared responsibility within the classroom.

Behaviour

We have recently seen an increased number of children spending their lunchtimes in Reflection due to behavioral issues.

If a child spends more than 2 periods in reflection a parent meeting will be required, this may result in your child being placed on report.

Please can we ask that you speak with your children about being respectful to all adults and peers. Staff are working hard to ensure parents/ carers are informed however if you have any concerns, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher.

We value a safe and positive school environment for all children, and we appreciate your support in reinforcing high behavioral standards at home.
